

TIPS FOR NEW MEMBERS

Now is really good time to recruit new playgroup team members. Identify who is interested in playing a role in the playgroup ministry – including session leaders, set up / pack away helpers, mat time leaders, prayer warriors, kitchen helpers, pastoral care , etc

WITH YOUR NEW TEAM MEMBERS

Discuss and share the vision or purpose and the goals of the playgroup ministry and the ways in which your playgroup is making this vision happen. This means all team members are on the 'same page'

Have a get together over coffee for the existing team members and the new team members to get to know each other and build relationships. Have some fun together!

Share necessary information to ensure all team members know what is happening.

Go through what happens in a normal playgroup session. Invite them to come and visit playgroup to get a feel for the group.

Utilise the strengths of the people involved – work with their gifts and abilities

Remember, a team is a group of people working together .. with concern for the benefit of the group as a whole rather than for individual interest.
