

Father's Day Ideas

This annual celebration in September is a great opportunity to have some fun, make something special for Daddy, or get the families in both your Playgroup and the church together.

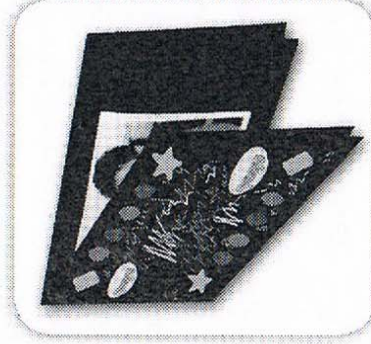
Below are a few ideas you might like to think about and use in your Playgroup.

Wallet Cards

This craft will take 2 + weeks to prepare, as photos of the children are needed.

You will need :

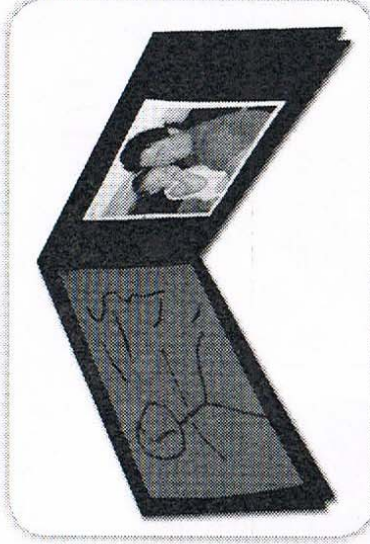
- photos of all the children
- brown or black cardboard
- Coloured paper
- Decorations - cut outs, glitter, pictures from magazines, etc
- crayons
- glue



ADULTS: Precut brown or black cardboard rectangles and fold them in half. These will make the 'wallets'.

Take photos of the children (with parents permission)

CHILDREN: Glue a coloured piece of paper to the inside right-hand side of the wallet. Children can write, draw or decorate on this.



Decorate the front of the wallet eg cut out pictures from magazines, glitter, confetti, bright coloured crayons, and much more!

Write the child's name on the back of the wallet

WEEK 2: When the photos are developed, cut out and paste them onto the inside left hand side of the 'wallet'.

A Useful Tin

You will need :

- a cleaned tin (no sharp edges)
- contact or paper to cover the tin
- Glue
- Decorations - Felt pieces, ribbons, glitter, cutouts, stickers

ADULTS : Cover the clean tin with contact or glue on coloured paper.

CHILDREN : Decorate the outside of the tin, gluing felt bits, material pieces, ribbons, cutouts, glitter, or anything else you can find !

Daddy can then fill the tin with pens, screws, tools or odds and ends.
