Week 1	<p>Creativity</p> <p>Trace around child's hand and cut out. Attach to icypole stick with fingers pointing out the side. Add eye and colour or stick stickers onto.</p>	<p>Jelly fish puppets made from cardboard with clear cellophane tentacles and attach to straw on icypole stick.</p>	<p>Cover table three sides with dark blue sheet, leaving front open. Attach to front of table blue/clear cellophane strips. Put cream carpet squares inside. Include fish hand puppets in large cane basket.</p>	<p>Large wooden Noah's ark with wooden animals. Encourage the children to create their own arks from blocks. Include large plastic sea animals and pieces of blue material nearby</p>	<p>Water (add blue food colouring) in water trough with plastic fish. Add weekly small and large shells, coral pieces, large plastic turtles, plastic fish tank grass/weed, other sea animals (sharks, whales, etc)</p>
Week 2	<p>Dramatic</p> <p>Set up small fish tank with children. Introduce gold fish.</p>	<p>Starfish cut out of cardboard to paste sand onto.</p>	<p>Group discussion/display using fish pictures to begin the children thinking/learning about the magnitude of God's handiwork in the sea.</p>	<p>Songs could include: All the fish, Three little fishes, (Pg84-85 The New Useful Book) 3 Jelly Fish, Books could include: One Less Fish (Kim Michelle Toff & Allan Sheather), Looking for Crabs (Bruce Whatley), Fidgety Fish (Ruth Caloway)</p>	<p>Lots of small fish to paste onto blue circle. Dolphin shape to paste grey leather shapes onto.</p>
Week 3	<p>Construction</p> <p>Large wooden Noah's ark with wooden animals. Encourage the children to create their own arks from blocks. Include large plastic sea animals and pieces of blue material nearby</p>	<p>Fish cut out to paste metallic paper onto and hang from net in room.</p>	<p>Hunting Game ~ Clear plastic fish tank with clear and blue cellophane strips. Add brightly coloured fish.</p>	<p>Magnet fishing game on blue material and surrounded by plastic hoop.</p>	<p>Scahorse shape to paint with ~sand in paint~ and hang from net in room.</p>
Week 4	<p>Sensory/Messy</p> <p>Water (add blue food colouring) in water trough with plastic fish. Add weekly small and large shells, coral pieces, large plastic turtles, plastic fish tank grass/weed, other sea animals (sharks, whales, etc)</p>	<p>Jelly fish made from cardboard cylinders and green/blue tentacles hanging from cellophane.</p>	<p>Fish puzzles</p>	<p>Rainbow Fish Memory Game</p>	<p>Small fish to attach to clear cellophane and hang from edge of shoe box to create cellophane fish.</p>
Week 5	<p>Language</p> <p>Group discussion/display using fish pictures to begin the children thinking/learning about the magnitude of God's handiwork in the sea.</p>	<p>Crabs made from 2 paper plates stapled together, wooden clothes pegs for nippers and pipe cleaners or bendy straws for legs.</p>	<p>Fish puzzles</p>	<p>Rainbow Fish Memory Game</p>	<p>Small fish to attach to clear cellophane and hang from edge of shoe box to create cellophane fish.</p>
